We're thrilled to announce the upcoming awards ceremony and winners' concert scheduled to take place at the Zipper Hall, Colburn School of Performing Arts in Los Angeles, CA, on July 21, 2024, exclusively for our select winners. For more information and eligibility criteria, please refer to the Prizes page.

Competition Schedule and Deadlines

The competition will be held in two rounds -1) the preliminary round and 2) the final round.

- Regional Preliminary Round Application Deadlines and Results: Check the website
 - Please enter the competition (1) in the region where the entrant has permanent residence or (2) in the region where the instruction takes place. For distance learning, the state where the instruction takes place is defined as where the entrant is located during Zoom, FaceTime lessons or similar means of instruction.
- Final Round Registration Deadline: June 24th, 2024, 11:59pm PT
 - Announcement of the Final Round Results: July 15th, 2024, by email
- Awards Ceremony & Winners' Concerts: July 21st, 2024 at Colburn's Zipper Hall

All recordings must be audiovisual. Only the top prize winners will advance to the final round. The final round of registration ends on June 24th, 2024. However, the contestant has the right to switch to an "in-person" final round (see "in-person" regulations), which will be held in Los Angeles, USA from July 18th, 2024. The awards ceremony and winners' concert will be held in Zipper Hall at the Colburn School on July 21st, 2024. Prize-winners invited to the Awards Ceremony & Winners' Concert are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses.

Registration Instructions

- The competition is open to participants of all nationalities.
- Please fill in the competition registration form accurately and ensure the authenticity and validity. If there is any false information, the qualification will be canceled.
- Contestants need to accurately select the group according to their year of birth.
- Only one piece is allowed to be the same between the preliminary and the final round.
- The qualifications for professional contestants are from full-time art music precollege/colleges and professional students from the attached middle school and primary school of the Conservatory of Music.

Registration Fees (all payments are non-refundable)

The regional preliminary round application fee is indicated at the end of the application form. If you are accepted to the final round, there is an additional Final Round fee of \$150 for all finalists. The prize winners from the final round are invited to perform in the **Zipper Hall** on July 21st, 2024. There are no fees to participate in the Winners' Concert for first-prize winners. Repertoire

1. Preliminary Round:

<u>Categories and Repertoire Requirements for Preliminary Round</u>: 1-3 works from the Baroque to the 21st century by a standard classical music composer. Groups 1 to 4 will be divided into "Professional" and "Amateur" levels. All professional group contestants will compete in separate categories from Amateur competitions according to their age groups. The contestant entering the professional groups 1-4 must include an etude in the program. Individual/separate movements from larger works are acceptable.

Group 1: born in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 - free program, no longer than 5 mins

Group 2: born in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 - free program, no longer than 7 mins

Group 3: born in 2009, 2010, 2011- free program, no longer than 13 mins

Group 4: born in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 - free program, no longer than 17 mins

Group 5 "Young Professional" Category: born between 1990-2004 - free program, must include one movement from the Baroque or Classical period, no longer than 17 mins.

Group 6 "Best Teacher" Category: eligible for teachers only (no age limit) – free program, must include one movement from the Baroque or Classical period, no longer than 17 minutes.

Announcement of the Preliminary Round Results:

- All participants will be notified of the jury's decision by e-mail no more than 3 weeks after the deadline. The diploma will be sent online directly to laureates.
- Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize winners may advance to the final rounds. The deadline to register for the final round is June 15th, 2024, 11:59pm PT (online).

2. Final Round:

<u>Categories and Repertoire Requirements for Final Round</u>: 1 or 2 works from the Baroque to the 21st century. Individual/separate movements from larger works are acceptable.

Group 1: born in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 - free program, 4-5 mins

Group 2: born in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 - free program, 5-7 mins

Group 3: born in 2009, 2010, 2011- free program, 8-10 mins

Group 4: born in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 - free program, 10-12 mins

Group 5 "Young Professional" Category: born between 1990-2004 - free program of 12-20 mins. Group 6 "Best Teacher" Category: eligible for teachers only (no age limit) – free program of 12-20 minutes.

Announcement of the Final Round Results:

- All participants will be notified of the jury's decision by e-mail on July 15th, 2024.
- The diploma will be sent online directly to laureates.
- Prize-winners invited to the final concert are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses.

Competition rules

- 1. All performances must be memorized.
- 2. If the total number of contestants in each group is less than 10, the organizing committee has the right to combine the awards.
- 3. Applicants studying with any of the Preliminary and Final Round judges are eligible to apply, but will not receive votes/scores from their teacher.
- 4. If the contestant fails to perform within the specified time, the judges have the right to stop listening to the video beyond the time, but it will not affect the scoring result.
- 5. Contestants who fail to register before the deadline will be dealt with by the organizing committee as an automatic withdraw.
- 6. All prizes will be awarded unless the judges unanimously decide not to award one or more of the prizes. In case of a tie, the judges may decide to split a prize between two competitors. All decisions of the jury will be final and there is no appeal or review.
- 7. All prizes and/or earnings are subject to taxation in accordance with the USA tax regulations.
- 8. All travel and accommodation expenses and accompanying personnel expenses are the responsibility of the participants themselves.
- 9. Any situation not covered by these rules shall be referred to the organizing committee, which makes the final decision on such matters.

Final Awards: All prize winners will receive diplomas. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize winners will also receive a trophy. The finalists will receive personalized certificates of recognition. All top prize winners will be featured on the official social media pages.

- 1st prize of Group 1-4 Professional & Amateur division: \$1000 (\$150 cash+ \$850 scholarship for 2025 Orbifold Music Festival) + Winner's Concert Showcase
- 2nd prize of Group 1-4 Professional & Amateur division: \$700 (\$100 cash+ \$600 scholarship for 2025 Orbifold Music Festival)
- 3rd prize of Group 1-4 Professional & Amateur division: \$500 (\$50 cash+ \$450 scholarship for 2025 Orbifold Music Festival)
- 4th, 5th, 6th, Honorable Mentions, and other special prizes of all groups will receive a diploma

*All First Prize winners will receive a personalized letter of recommendation for the college application process upon request. High school finalists in our past competitions have gone on to enroll in prestigious academic institutions such as Stanford University, University of Southern California, and University of California, Berkeley.

** Top 3 prizes music teachers will receive personalized certificates of recognition.
